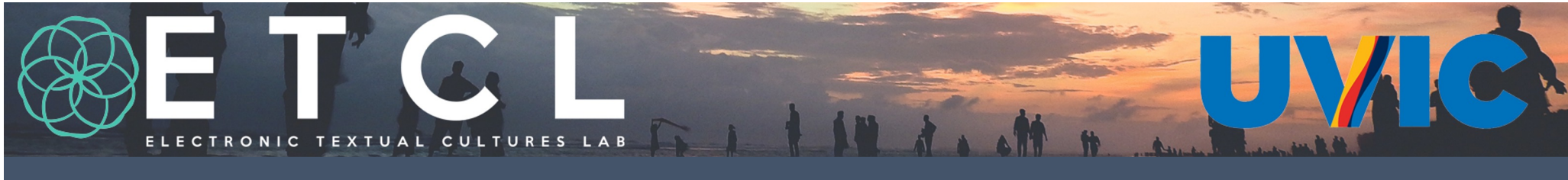

## Key Features of the Canadian HSS Commons

- Canadian servers and digital research infrastructure
- Code is open source and shared on GitHub
- Users can sign in using federated identity services (ORCID, CAF)
- Integrated project development space (Dropbox, GitHub, Google)
- Open access subject repository (DOIs, versioning)
- Research sharing and communication tools





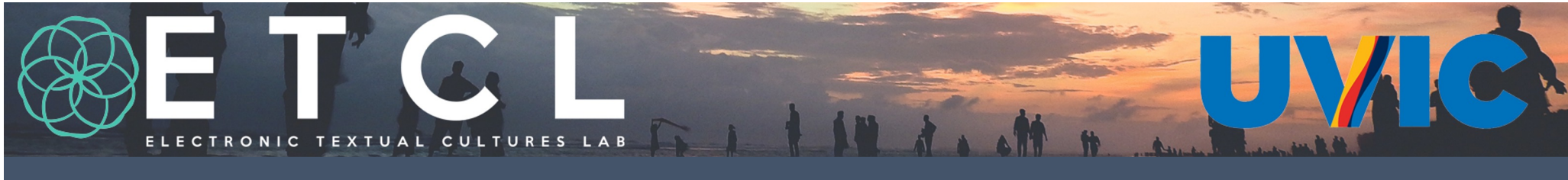
## What is Knowledge Mobilization?

- Putting knowledge into action
- A complex term, AKA knowledge translation, brokerage, transmission, exchange, etc., often associated with health sciences
- Relates to research impact, research data management, community-engaged research, openness
- Considering what knowledge is generated, who will be interested in it, how best to share it; also evaluating how well those strategies work
- Making information FAIR (Findable, Accessible, Interoperable, Reusable) (see Wilkinson et al.)

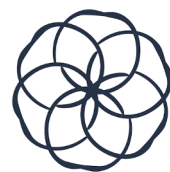
